Throughout the year, we will feature various keynote speakers and panel presentations, as well as providing various small working groups so that students can get as much prep information and individualized support for their college applications as possible. Students will also learn about the financial aid process, building their college list and adjusting to life in a new school environment. This will be an opportunity for students to get an in depth look at the Ivy League, Hidden Ivies, State Schools, Public Ivies, and learn about various academic programs at these schools, and careers post-college.

Our goal is to give students an insight into the college application process from several points of view. We also offer a unique, stress-free, shadowing program for underclassmen to avoid panic situations during their senior year. Students who attend consistently become eligible to participate in our hands-on college editing workshops in the fall, where alumni help students complete their applications. It is fundamental to our foundation's mission that students never pay for college access help.

We also believe in creating a positive, nurturing environment to eliminate a cutthroat attitude in the application process. As such, students from all walks of life are welcome to attend.
